

Dalton Release 2 Site Licence Agreement

Dalton is an experimental code for the calculation of molecular properties.

A site licence for Dalton Release 2 means that the site may install and make generally available the executable, scripts, utility programs, basis sets and the manual of the Dalton program subject to the terms given below. This agreement applies to all revisions of Release 2, that is, all versions denoted by Dalton Release 2.x, where x is the revision number. In the following all references to Dalton refer to all parts of Dalton Release 2, that is, all files in the distribution as well as generated object files and executables.

In order to obtain and make available Dalton Release 2, the site is required to agree to the following terms:

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 - (b) When the site stop using a computer, proper actions will be taken to make sure that all Dalton files, including object files and executables, are deleted on that computer.
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 - (d) Changes in the source code are only to be made in order to make the code compile and perform correctly on the site, as well as to upgrade the code through patches supplied from the authors.
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2. No fee may be charged for the use of the program or any part of the program.
3. Users are to be informed that the experimental nature of this program means that there is no warranty of correctness of results nor fitness for a particular purpose and that the authors of Dalton cannot be held responsible in any way for any consequences arising from the use of the program. While every attempt will be made to correct any errors reported to dalton-admin@kjemi.uio.no, the authors of Dalton are not obliged to make such corrections, nor is there any support for users implied by making the program available.
4. The users must be informed that any published work arising from use of the Dalton program must acknowledge the program with an appropriate citation. A suitable text for Release 2 revision 0 would be:
